Truck Features:

- Walkthrough mid mount pump panel
- 1000 gallon poly water tank
- 30 gallon foam tank
- FoamPro foam system
- Detachable deck-gun with variable nozzle for low clearance overhead
- Two 1 ¾ preconnect crosslay hose beds
- One 2 ½ preconnect crosslay hose bed
- One 2 ½ preconnect in hose bed
- LDH bed with room for 1000' of 4" or 5 " LDH
- 2 air pack jump seats
- 3 air pack storage in cabinet
- 3 spare air bottle compartments above wheels
- 2 bottle hooks in rear
- 5000 Watt Honda generator w/ electric start
- 2 telescoping scene lights
- 24' extension ladder
- 14' roof ladder



E3 is a Custom 1995 Emergency-One (E-One) Hurricane Pumper. The cab seats 5, a 3-man bench in front and 2 jump seats, one on either side of the doghouse which contains a Detroit 6V92T and a rebuilt Alison Auto transmission.

E3 currently has 37,500 miles.

The pump is a 1250 GPM Hale single stage pump with less than 500 pump hours (passed annual pump test Oct 2020).

All emergency lights, electronic siren, airhorn & Q2B included and in working order.
